Trinidad is home to a remarkable variety of birds and animals. Above, the Trinidad Piping Guan, one of perhaps 400 remaining. It's one of the many unusual sightings a group of HRAS travelers saw in Trinidad last April. In the Caroni Swamp, we witnessed the sunset roosting of thousands of scarlet ibis, their color intensified by the setting sun. Sitting on the veranda of the Asa Wright Nature Center — sometimes with our cameras, sometimes with a rum punch — we saw over 10 species of hummingbirds. The beaches were nesting sights of the endangered Leatherback Turtle. Three were seen and photographed by our group.
